He was the 4th President of FOGSI installed at the 47th AICOG at Agra in 2004. He had the honour of being the second President of FOGSI from the same family after his famous father. He was the Chairperson of Female Breast Committee from 1999 to 2004.

He was also the Senior Vice President of FOGSI in 1999-2000 and President of Ahmedabad Society in 1996-97. He was very keen that the smaller societies should be involved in academic programmes so he initiated the concept of satellite conferences which would be relayed to remote places. He is now the convenor of the satellite conferences of FOGSI. The official theme of FOGSI during his year was - Modern Technologies for the Underprivileged Women. He firmly believed that-
