

## Letter to Editor (NESOG News)

Dear SAFOG colleagues,

I extend warm greetings from NESOG on behalf of the new executive board for the tenure 2013 to 15 that took over during our international conference held on 4th to 5th April, 2013, at Kathmandu. We are looking forward for very busy calendar for these 2 years, as NESOG has grown to more mature young adult organization and is heading toward celebrating its 25th year of foundation on 14th November, 2014.

The executive board has expanded enormously by revising its committees and establishing more sub-committees to scale up area of support to our partners by building better capacity in our specialty as well as reproductive health services. Our new advocacy committee has started innovative work of developing advocacy materials by producing public service announcements (PSAs) in MNH, TV clip on promoting girl child health and doc drama on 'abandoning prenatal sex determination' under FIGO-LOGIC additional work plan before this project phase out in October 2013. Similarly, the education committee is planning to work on standardizing MD/DGO curriculum for ensuring quality and uniform Post Graduate Education throughout the country. The public health and research committee is writing proposal to mobilize grant for continuity of work in those areas where the government needs support from the professional organization. The training and capacity building committee is made up of various sub-committees, particularly subspecialties in obstetrics and gynecology to work on exploring training opportunities for our members in various subspecialties.



We have revived CEOC services at Dhankuta district of eastern Nepal, once again and trying to lobby, to post one gynecologist there for continuity of services. The most promising upcoming activity of NESOG is the 'Systemic Review Workshop' from 24th to 26th August, at Kathmandu, to help members understand systemic review of studies for developing guidelines/protocols. The chief faculty for this workshop is Prof J Neilson from Liverpool, UK.
